experience often opens the eyes of the students to what will be expected of them when they enter the workforce.

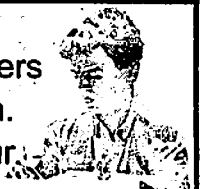
"We would like to express appreciation for all of the employers that were willing to provide this opportunity for the students," she said.
